

Poster Contest

Participation rules

- It's only allowed 1 poster per registration.
- All posters submitted to competition must describe an original production/scientific investigation; on Friday 21st of November at 14h, all the posters accepted to the contest have to be presented to the public. The presentation have to be done in 3 minutes (maximum)
- Language: English.
- For a poster be submitted to contest, first is required a registration in the event (in the registration form, please select the option related with poster contest). After that, one of the registered authors must send the summary of the poster to **logistica@nebfeupicbas.pt** until **November 14th** (inclusive), being the subject of the e-mail in accordance with the following model: "**Poster Summary - [full name of participant]**". Summaries sent after this date will not be considered to contest.
- The works whose author responsible for the registration doesn't attend at the evaluation will be disqualified.
- The posters **must be printed** in size A0 and delivered at the reception desk of the event during registration on the November 21st.
- The contest will only be held by the registration of a minimal number of 10 posters. In case of cancellation of the contest, all subscribers will be advised.
- The organization reserves the right to conduct a prior selection of works that will be presented and led to competition given its quality and framing in the theme of the event. The authors of the works led to contest will be informed of the **acceptance of the poster until November 18th**.
- The evaluation will be proceeded by the Scientific Committee members of the event.
- If more than one participant is author of a poster, only one of the authors should be indicate on the application to the poster contest, i.e., there should be only one participant responsible for each poster. Rules for preparation of the summary:
 - The summary should not exceed 600 words. Summaries exceeding this limit will be excluded from the contest.
 - Should not contain illustrations, diagrams, charts, algorithms, or any other attachments.
 - Must be written in English.
